

## EASTER 2009

### If you knew that you had only five days to live, how would you order your days?

Jesus entered Jerusalem on Sunday, April 6, 32 A.D. (Luke 19:28-44 NIV). He was crucified and died on Friday afternoon at about 3 PM. This gave Him approximately 120 hours to fulfill any remaining work the Father had given Him to do. We know from John 12:23-27 that this was "The hour ... for the Son of Man to be glorified."

The Psalmist instructed us to ask our LORD to "Teach us to number our days aright," (Psalm 90:12). This means that we need to live with the constant awareness of the brevity of life and consciously request that the Holy Spirit direct our life choices. Easter has a lot of significant meanings and applications, and one of those applications is to be motivated to take every opportunity to fulfill our God-ordained destiny by living intentionally (Ephesians 2:10).

This Easter season, we will approach Holy Week with spiritual intentionality. Beginning with Palm Sunday on Sunday, April 5, our gatherings are designed to anticipate that the Holy Spirit will speak to us regarding the significance of Christ's suffering, crucifixion, and resurrection. On **Wednesday and Thursday, April 8 and 9**, from 5 – 8 PM and

on **Friday, April 10**, from 5 – 7 PM, in the Fellowship Center will be set up with various stations where you and your family can participate in activities that will remind you of different aspects of Christ's life, death and resurrection. Moving through the stations will take approximately 45 minutes, and you can come and go any time during the hours listed above. During our Good Friday service on **Friday, April 10**, at 7:30 PM, you will be invited to nail your spiritual intentions to one of four large wooden crosses, and then receive a "spike" illustrating the work that Christ has accomplished and will accomplish through your surrendered life. We will also share Communion together. Finally, we will celebrate the Resurrection of our LORD on **Saturday, April 11**, at 4 PM\* and on **Sunday, April 12**, at 6:32 AM†, 9AM\* and 11:15 AM.†

I have heard many positive stories of how the Holy Spirit has been empowering, illuminating and infusing our church family to be led by Him our Counselor! During this Easter season and always, prepare your motives, wills and emotions to follow the powerful movement of the Holy Spirit.
